

As part of ongoing efforts to keep residents, businesses and officials up-to-date on recycling and solid waste information in Essex County:

E-Waste Management in Essex County

Effective January 1, 2011

The New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP) has enacted new regulations under The New Jersey Electronic Waste Management Act (N.J.A.C. 7:26a-13) effective January 1, 2011, which bans landfilling of *certain* electronics as solid waste. These electronic items called “*Covered Electronics*,” which include televisions, desktop or personal computers, monitors, portable/laptop computers and telephones with video display areas greater than 4” (measured diagonally), must be recycled. All other electronics are considered “*Non-Covered Electronics*”, and are not required to be diverted for recycling. Further, manufacturers of “*Covered Electronics*” are now required to develop E-Waste Management Programs that set forth programs of how they will collect their NJDEP-prescribed tonnages of these units.

Working to successfully implement this new program in Essex County, residents can now recycle all “*Covered Electronics*” at Advanced Recovery, Inc., 50 Grafton Avenue, Newark, New Jersey 07104 FREE of charge.
