Recycling Coordinator Bi-Monthly Meeting

November 27, 2012 – Essex County Environmental Center – Roseland

The SWAC/Recycling Meeting has been approved for 2 CRP "Meeting" credits!

1. Tonnage Reports:

- BSG has begun reaching out to recycling facilities to put them on notice that we will be requesting 2012 recycling tonnage data when available;
- BSG has researched additional recycling facilities above and beyond those from which we requested tonnage data for 2011;
- BSG will once again provide a summarized collection of recycling tonnages from various facilities in one cohesive document to aid in municipal reporting in Spring 2013, prior to the Tonnage Reporting deadline.

2. Hurricane Sandy and Temporary Debris Management Areas:

- NJDEP requires all municipalities operating staging areas for debris to submit an application form (submitted previously to all SWAC members via Email);
- Completed form must be accompanied by County Office of Emergency Management approval, as well as local Fire Marshall approval;
- Putrescible wastes, Wa lboard, Gypsum, Sheetrock, Hazardous wastes, Household hazardous wastes and E-waste must be stored on an impervious (paved) surface;
- Any putrescible solid wastes such as Type 10 household waste may only stay on site for 7 days before requiring NJDEP to approve an extension;
- Other wastes such as vegetative debris, white goods, masonry debris, C&D wood waste debris, E-waste and hazardous waste may stay on site for 60 days before an extension is required.
- Federal OSHA (not PEOSH) has begun auditing debris staging areas in Morristown County and may extend audits into other Counties;
- Municipalities are reminded that they must follow OSHA requirements for personal protective equipment (PPE), confined space entry, heavy equipment use, work zone safety, traffic control, crane/aerial lift use, and other applicable topics;
- All TDMAs must be approved by NJDEP in order for operations to be eligible for FEMA reimbursement.

3. Certified Recycling Professional (CRP) Recertification:

- For those whose CRP certifications are expiring at the end of 2012, recertification forms are due to Rutgers-OCPE by January 31, 2013;
- A total of 20 credits are required: a minimum of six (6) must be classroom or course-based training, while the remaining fourteen (14) hours can be earned through meetings, conferences or other technical training;
- These credits must have been acquired between January 1, 2011, and December 31, 2012;

- Each Essex County SWAC meeting was approved for 2 "meeting" credits each during that time period, with the exception of the January 2012 meeting which was also approved for 1 classroom credit;
- Additional credits may be claimed through Rutgers courses; ANCR Symposia, ANCR Annual Meetings, NJ WasteWise meetings, APWANJ meetings, etc.
