### **1. Tonnage Reports:**

- BSG continues to notify recycling facilities that we will request 2012 tonnage data when available;
  - BSG has identified and queried additional recycling facilities for tonnage data since 2011;
  - BSG will once again provide a summarized collection of recycling tonnages from various facilities in one cohesive document to aid in municipal reporting in Spring 2013, prior to the Tonnage Reporting deadline.

### **2. Covered Electronic Devices (CEDs) Recycling Data requested by NJDEP:**

- CEDs defined as:
    - “desktop or personal computer, computer monitor, portable computer, or television sold to a consumer, or a phone with a video display area greater than four inches measured diagonally”
  - NJDEP has requested quarterly data from Essex County for recycled CEDs (not the more broad categories of E-waste or Consumer Electronics) in order to determine the State’s fulfillment of its recycling tonnage goals;
  - If your municipality uses Advanced Recovery (Newark, NJ) or Newtech (Somerset, NJ), then we already have your data and there’s no need to provide additional information;
  - But, if your municipality uses an E-waste recycler other than those above, please provide the name and contact person of the facility you use and we will obtain the necessary information directly from them.

### **3. Debris Management Survey Responses for NJDEP:**

- NJDEP sent Debris Management Surveys to Municipal Clerks and Mayors for completion by Public Works Directors regarding the management of debris caused by Superstorm Sandy;
  - According to the cover letter from NJDEP:
    - “Results from this survey will help us fine-tune our waste debris volume estimates and ensure that all debris management areas are being approved and accounted for so that you can receive FEMA reimbursement.”
  - County Recycling and Solid Waste Coordinators were asked to assist municipalities complete the surveys and return them;
  - Survey responses received from the following municipalities thus far:
    - East Orange, Fairfield, Glen Ridge, Maplewood, Montclair and South Orange.

### **4. Smoke Detectors**

- County resident faced policy change at Kidde, who no longer accepts residential units
  - Nuclear Regulatory Commission advises that domestic smoke detectors are sold as exempt units and remain exempt from regulatory requirements upon disposal.
  - Several vendors will still accept them, but for a fee.
