Meeting – January 25, 2011

The regularly scheduled meeting of the Essex County Solid Waste Advisory Council was held on Tuesday, January 25, 2011 at Essex County Environmental Center, 621 Eagle Rock Ave, Roseland, NJ. The meeting began at 1:00 pm.

1. CALL TO ORDER

Richard Fernicola-Chairperson called the Essex County Solid Waste Advisory Council meeting to order at 1:00 PM and thanked everyone for attending.

2. OPEN PUBLIC MEETING STATEMENT

The meeting is in accordance with the Open Public Meeting Act. Publication of the meeting of the Essex County Solid Waste Advisory Council had previously been made and the public is invited to speak as noted on the agenda.

Essex County Utilities Authority

Mr. Maddaloni informed the committee members that latex paint would not be accepted by municipalities at the next HHW day. The NJDEP suggests that unwanted latex paint be donated and/or use or can be dried-out and disposed of in the regular trash. Mr. Maddaloni advised those in attendance the total solid waste disposed of at our designated facilities for 2010 was 592, 046 approximately 60000 tons less from 2009. E-waste letters were distributed advising the municipalities that reidnets can bring their covered electronics to Advance Recovery Inc.
